



Screen Time Policy

Because we care about the health and well-being of the children in our care, we follow best practice recommendations on screen time:

Children under 3 should have no screen time.

Children aged 3 and over should watch a maximum of intermittent screen time for 1 hour per week whilst at the nursery.

Screen time includes the use of online videos, computers, and video games for educational purposes only. We have added additional security for online searches in the form of web content filtering, blocking unsafe categories.

Our nursery understands that screen time can get in the way of playtime, physical activity, and interactions with others, which all contribute to learning and healthy physical/social development.

Therefore, we will restrict screen time by adhering to the following guidelines:

- We allow a maximum of 1 hour per week of educational, age appropriate screen time.
- We allow zero screen time for children under the age of three.
- We do not allow the laptop to be left on as background noise.
- We do not offer screen time as a reward.
- We do not allow children access to the computer whilst unsupervised.
